§ 1 Application / Scope

- (1) This contract regulates the organisation of the study programme Business Administration and Engineering (Master) in the winter semester 2021/2022 including programme fee and semester fees.
- (2) The above-named student has been admitted to the programme at Hochschule für Technik und Wirtschaft Berlin (University of Applied Science) (HTW Berlin), beginning in the winter semester 2021/2022.

§ 2 Regulations / Programme Duration

- (1) Study is organised on the basis of the Study and Examination Regulations of the programme at HTW Berlin in their respectively valid editions.
- (2) The attended programme Business Administration and Engineering (Master) has a duration of 18 months (3 subject semesters regular study period).

§ 3 Student Rights and Obligations

- (1) By signing this contract and paying the programme fee and semester fees, the student gains the right to attend teaching sessions in accordance with the programme plan, sit examinations and receive support for the completion of a Master's thesis. The programme plan forms part of the Study Regulations mentioned above.

- (2) HTW Berlin's facilities are available for the use of the student as per the scope of the programme. This applies in particular to the library and computer centre. To prove his/her right to use these facilities, the student shall receive a StudentCard.
- (3) The student is obliged to organise his/her study plan such that he/she is able to complete the programme within the time period stipulated in the study plan contained in the Study Regulations. The student is bound by the regulations valid at HTW Berlin as well as any arrangements determined under the authority of the HTW Berlin's organisational bodies.

§ 4 Responsibilities of HTW Berlin

HTW Berlin is obliged to organise the programme in accordance with the Study Regulations and Examination Regulations such that it can be completed by the student within the time period stipulated in the study plan contained in the Study Regulations. The programme is run by the HTW Berlin's Division of Continuing Education (ZbWS).

§ 5 Programme Fee/ Semester Fees

- (1) The programme participant is required to pay a programme fee in the amount of 12,500.00 EUR for the 3- semester training programme. In addition, the semester fee is to be paid each semester.
- (2) The programme fee in the amount of 12,500.00 EUR are payable upon admission and conclusion of the contract (see notice of admission for the bank transfer beneficiary and date). The programme fee can also be paid in 3 instalments, one per semester, in connection with enrolment and re-registration.
 1. instalment -> see notice of admission: 4,500.00 EUR
 2. instalment at the latest by 05.02.2022: 4,000.00 EUR
 3. instalment at the latest by 15.07.2022: 4,000.00 EUR
- (3) If the regular study period of 3 semesters is exceeded by more than one semester, from the 5th subject semester additional programme fees in the amount of 1,500.00EUR are payable.

§ 6 Conclusion of the Contract

- (1) The contractual relationship shall end when:
 - a) The programme is successfully completed with the handing over of the Master's Grade Transcript and Master's Degree Certificate
 - b) The programme fee and/or the semester fee are/is not paid by the deadline stipulated
 - c) Examinations are irrevocably failed as set out in the programme's Examination Regulations.

- (2) In the case of para. 1, letter b) and c), HTW Berlin is not obliged to reimburse programme fee and semester fee(s) already paid.
- (3) If a student does not begin the programme or terminates studies within the first four weeks of the semester, half of the first-semester fee will be retained. If studies are terminated at a later point in time, there will be no entitlement to reimbursement. If the total programme fee of the further education Master's programme has already been paid, arrangements can be made on a case-by-case basis by the HTW Berlin University Board based on the proposals from the Division of Continuing Education (ZbwS).

§ 7 Final Provisions

- (1) Any supplements to the contract must be made in writing.
- (2) The place of jurisdiction is Berlin.
- (3) The contract shall be drawn in the German language.

§ 8 Entry into force

- (1) This contract is subject to the resolutive condition that the number of students enrolled on the programme meets the minimum number stipulated in § 3, paragraph 3 of the Eligibility and Admission Regulations for the further education programme Business Administration and Engineering (Master).
- (2) This contract is subject to the resolutive condition that projections based on the number of students admitted to the programme substantially exceed the student number stipulated in § 3, paragraph 3 of the Eligibility and Admission Regulations for the programme Business Administration and Engineering (Master).
- (3) The contract shall come into force upon signing.
