- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the IT organization and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry.



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Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **Dynamisity Pvt Ltd, Ahmedabad**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **Technical/Training Partner** or **Dynamisity Pvt Ltd, Ahmedabad**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar day's notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations





(Hereinafter referred to as 2nd Party).

Together both may be referred to as "Parties"

Recitals

- I. Whereas, IBM SkillsBuild represented by its country partner for India - REACHA, is a skill building & learning digital platform where users can achieve industry relevant skills, get IBM certified badges & seek employment opportunities for free.
- II. Whereas **Sinhgad Institute of Technology** is being premier Institute is committed to fulfill aspirations for excellence in technical education, produce competent engineers and good human being. The institute has 175 acres artistically landscaped, lush green campus, conducive to learning. We strive to develop SIT as a benchmark in engineering education. It is an ultimate destination for students to groom their overall personality along with academic excellence. These are achieved through Value Addition Programmes (VAPs), Student Training Programmes (STP), Lab Innovations, Project Based Learning, Cultural activities, Technical events, etc.
- III. Whereas the 1st Party wants to collaborate with specialized agencies/institutions to achieve industry relevant skills required under the IBM SkillsBuild Project.
- IV. Whereas the 2nd Party has shown interest in providing desired skills required by the 1st Party for implementation of the IBM SkillsBuild Project.
- V. Whereas, at the suggestion of 2nd Party, 1st Party has agreed to collaborate with 2nd Party for availing their expertise for SkillsBuild Project for various activities as listed hereinafter.

Objectives

1. The objective of this LoU is to mutually complement both above parties' energies, outreach, and efforts to curate opportunities of collaboration, sharing of knowledge resources and jointly work on building capacities of the users through the IBM SkillsBuild Platform.
2. Both parties will enable SkillsBuild for 100+ students from Lonavala, with prime focus in States of Maharashtra. Both Parties will work together to achieve this target.
3. The identified students would be encouraged to take up and complete courses on IBM SkillsBuild by both parties mentioned. 2nd Party must ensure a minimum of 80% attendance and activity per month of onboarded learners.

Duration

This LoU is initially upto 31st March 2022.

Operational Aspects

Both parties will work closely with their teams to leverage their student/learner base and other important stakeholders to build industry relevant skillset & enhance employability prospect of students/ learners by providing market-linked skills. 1st Party, i will facilitate the on-boarding of learners (students) on the platform with assistance and in collaboration with 2nd Party, and encourage students to leverage the platform for better learning opportunities.

2nd Party must ensure a minimum of 80% attendance and course completion on IBM Skillsbuild platform per user per month, participation in innovation camps and other learning activities. 2nd party shall appoint a Single Point of Contact (SPOC)/ Volunteer faculty to act as facilitator between students and REACHA Digital Success Manager/team.

In order to maintain the desired level of social media outreach, each party promises to follow the branding guidelines for social media amplification sent as a part of the communication package as per IBM norms/approved by IBM on case to case basis. With respect to the social media outreach, each party will also appoint an appropriate person(s) to represent the organization.

Termination and Extension of LoU

The collaboration covered by this LoU shall terminate on 31st March 2022.

Overview:

Responsibilities of College:

- Recognize Internshala as the internship and training partner in all internal and external communications including on its website and in admission/media brochures.



Wherein the parties have decided to enter a strategic alliance on terms mutually beneficial to them as provided in this MoU for the benefit of the College students.

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2. **Objectives of MoU**

The main objective of this MoU is to brand Birlasoft as an Employer of Choice amongst students of the Sinhgad Institutes and to initiate ACE program, (Academic Collaboration for Excellence), to provide a collaboration platform to build a strong and on-going relationship between Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" thereby bridging the Academia and Industry skills gap.

- The primary goals of ACE Program are –
 - Effective Campus Collaboration Program which would help in early engagement with the colleges and faculty
 - Aligning academics with business needs thereby ensuring expected skills at the time of on-boarding
 - To get a better placement slot from the campuses (Day 1 or Day 2) for hiring good quality of students from the batch.
 - Promote activities like Hackathons, Interaction sessions with SMEs and Business Leaders to brand Birlasoft and help in overall development of the students
 - Provide exposure to students & faculty members on emerging technologies
 - Offering courses of mutual to organization's interest to the students and issuing the students certificates jointly, upon successful completion of the course.
 - Exploring and carrying out any other academic activity with mutual consent.

3. **Coordination**

- 3.1 Under ACE Program, Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" shall establish a joint working group for coordination.

- 3.3 Both parties (Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes") shall take all reasonable steps to cooperate and ensure successful implementation of all the measures mentioned in this MoU.

4. **ACE Program Details**

The joint working group shall implement, administer and execute the following measures as under –

- 4.1 Academic curriculum planning
 - 4.1.1 Birlasoft shall participate in enriching the existing academic curriculum by providing the field inputs, technology driven changes to the Board of Studies (BoS) at the departmental level or the Departmental Academic Committee (DAC) or Birlasoft Business Sponsors can be a member on Board of Studies (BoS).

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- 4.1.2 This BoS and DAC shall take all such inputs to the cluster level BoS of the institute and finalize the curriculum.
- 4.2 Participation in knowledge sharing

 - 4.3.1 Birlasoft would conduct Faculty Development Program for the faculties of "Sinhgad Institutes" to conduct a methodology based training which would supplement and enhance existing pedagogy to make it more industry relevant, the trainings to be conducted would be mutually agreed between Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes".
 - 4.3.2 Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" would mutually identify faculties based on the below selection criteria:
 - 4.3.2.1 Technical faculty should have min 4 years of technical teaching experience in streams Computers/IT/E&TC.
 - 4.3.2.2 Power Skills faculty should have excellent command on English and preferably should have taken soft skills or power skills sessions earlier.
 - 4.3.2.3 Faculty should be a permanent employee of the college and should be minimum Asst. Professor grade or above.
 - 4.3.2.4 Specialization/Certification of faculties in relevant field would be an added advantage.
 - 4.3.3 The college faculties which are mutually identified by Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" would be conducting trainings in 2 phases: -
 - 4.3.3.1 Phase1: Before we offer the candidates following training would be conducted by faculties: -
 - 4.3.3.1.1 Methodology based training which would focus more on hands-on and problem-solving skills, as agreed by Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" for interested 3rd year and final year candidates.
 - 4.3.3.2 Phase2: Post we offer the candidates but before they pass-out from college following training would be conducted by faculties: -
 - 4.3.3.2.1 Business Unit specific training identified and agreed by Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" for Offered final year candidates.
 - 4.3.3.2.2 Business Unit specific Electives identified and agreed by Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" for Offered final year candidates.
 - 4.3.3.2.3 Timely feedbacks would be taken from the students and based on students' feedbacks and their assessment performance Birlasoft would have the rights to propose change of faculty for any training.
- 4.4 Placement support to "Sinhgad Institutes"
 - 4.4.1 This initiative aims at identification of the right young people who will join Birlasoft and their quest for being practice leaders in the niche areas we are focused on.
 - 4.4.2 Hence, Birlasoft shall recruit competent and potential students of final year UG programs depending on it's annual need and growth plan.

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- 4.4.3 Recruitment of competent students shall be governed by the selection process as per Birlasoft policy.
- 4.4.4 Birlasoft is under no compulsion to guarantee Placements to the students of "Sinhgad Institutes".
- 4.5 Training Program for candidates before they pass-out from College
- 4.5.1 Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes" would conduct Training program for Offered final year candidates of the college before they pass-out.
- 4.5.2 In this training program following would be covered: -
- Technical training delivered by College faculties
 - Power skills training delivered by College faculties with support from Birlasoft Power Skills team
 - Periodic SME Connects (Technical/Power Skills) by Birlasoft
 - Periodic Assignments (Technical/Power Skills) by Birlasoft
 - Periodic Assessments (Technical/Power Skills) by Birlasoft
- 4.5.3 Offered Candidates who would undergo this training need to complete the assignments as per the timelines given.
- 4.5.4 Offered Candidates who would undergo this training need to clear the assessments as per the criteria defined by "Sinhgad Institutes".

5. Summary of Responsibilities

5.1 College Responsibilities

- 5.1.1 To ensure maximum participation by students in Birlasoft activities and help in branding Birlasoft as Employer of choice among students.
- 5.1.2 To ensure minimum attendance of students as per the College attendance policy in all engagement activities defined by Birlasoft.
- 5.1.3 To share timely reports for the activities which are being conducted as a part of this initiative.
- 5.1.4 These reports should be shared with the Coordination committee of Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes"
- 5.1.5 To include any enhanced contents defined by Birlasoft to either be a part of College Academic Curriculum or be a part of Value-Added Program for the candidates.
- 5.1.6 To identify relevant college faculties who would undergo Faculty Development Program which would be conducted by Birlasoft.
- 5.1.7 To ensure the identified and trained college faculties successfully deliver the required defined content by Birlasoft to the students.
- 5.1.8 To ensure training quality is adhered and monitored, and in case there is a deviation necessary actions to be taken.
- 5.1.9 To ensure defined Electives by Birlasoft are made mandatory for Birlasoft Offered candidates.

5.2 Birlasoft Responsibilities

- 5.2.1 To ensure participation in Academic Curriculum planning or support in enhancing the existing curriculum with the college.

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- 5.2.2 To deliver technical presentations, webinars and talks which could be a part of the curriculum or as a value add to the students.
- 5.2.3 To conduct Faculty Development Program for the college faculties
- 5.2.4 To offer Electives to the students who have been offered by Birlasoft
- 5.2.5 To provide placement support to college students.
- 5.2.6 For Birlasoft offered candidates, monitor and track progress of their pre-onboarding training, conduct assignments and assessments during this training.
6. **Yearly review of this program to be conducted by Birlasoft and "Sinhgad Institutes"**
- 6.1 This review would comprise of a reviewing committee defined by Birlasoft which would include L&D Head, TA Head and Business Sponsors and "Sinhgad Institutes" which would include Principal or Dean of the College, HODs of various departments and Training and Placement Head of the college.
- 6.1.1 During this review which would be conducted inside the College campus, it is expected that College would present their perspective about the overall ACE Program in terms of effectiveness of the program from students and faculty point of view, feedback of the program from students and faculty point of view and whether the expected outcome was met in the end.
- 6.1.2 Also, during this review Birlasoft would present their perspective about the Overall ACE Program in terms of effectiveness of the activities done inside the college, feedback of students and faculties for the activities conducted by Birlasoft, and quality of hires done from the college.
- 6.2 This committee would review the clauses stated in this MOU and in case there is a breach anywhere then the committee would have rights to take the final decision whether to continue or discontinue the MoU.
7. **Selection process**
- 7.1 The entire recruitment procedure shall be decided by the Birlasoft Talent Acquisition Team which shall decide the procedure of campus recruitment including but not limited to selection criteria, selection process and elimination rounds.
8. **Confidentiality**
- 8.1 Either party may disclose its Confidential Information (as defined hereinafter) to the other party and the party disclosing the Confidential Information is referred as "Discloser" and the party receiving such information is referred as "Recipient".
- 8.2 Recipient shall keep the confidentiality of the Confidential Information of the Discloser and not use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which it the Confidential Information was provided to the Recipient.
- 8.3 Upon request by the Discloser, Recipient shall immediately return the Confidential Information of the Discloser.
- 8.4 "Confidential Information" shall mean and include Birlasoft proprietary technologies, all information and trade secrets exchanged by the parties hereto, including without limitation, technical or non-technical data, processes, know-how, business plans, forecasts, ideas, concepts, non-public financial plans and financial data, information about Birlasoft's clients and vendors and all other information, whether as a whole or any part thereof, that a reasonable person would deem confidential.

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- 8.5 Confidential Information shall not include information which: (a) is or becomes a part of the public domain through no act or omission of the Recipient; (b) can be shown to be already possessed by the Recipient as of the date of disclosure; (c) is made available to the Recipient on a non-confidential basis by a third party having a right to do so; or (d) is disclosed by order of a court of competent jurisdiction.
- 8.6 The obligation to maintain confidentiality shall survive this Agreement for a period of two (2) years from the date of disclosure.
- 8.7 "Sinhgad Institutes" shall cooperate with Birlasoft in getting Non-Disclosure Agreements signed by the students if such request is made by Birlasoft.
- 9. Miscellaneous**
- 9.1 This MoU under the ACE Program initiative of Birlasoft, shall be valid for a period of 24 months from the date of signing by "Sinhgad Institutes" & Birlasoft. This MoU shall be renewed for further term with mutual consent. Either party may decide to update or terminate this MoU by giving 30 days prior written notice to the other.
- 9.2 Neither party hereunder shall be liable for any consequential loss or damages arising out of the performance of obligations under the terms of this MoU.
- 9.3 Save in respect of Clause 8, Confidentiality, Birlasoft shall not have any liability or legal binding to "Sinhgad Institutes" by virtue of executing this MoU.
- 10. Limitation of liability**
- 10.1 In no event shall either party be liable to the other for any loss of profits, loss of revenue, loss of data, loss of use, any indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, punitive or consequential damages, incurred by either party or any third party, whether in an action in contract or tort, strict liability or other legal or equitable theory regardless of whether such damages were foreseeable or if the other party or any other person has been advised of the possibility of such damages.
- 11. Force Majeure**
- 11.1 Neither party to this MoU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MoU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- 11.2 Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MoU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MoU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.
- 12. Governing law and Jurisdiction:**
- 12.1 This MoU shall be governed by the laws of India. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Pune.







There are four Regional Training Centers at Nashik, Aurangabad, Sangli & Amravati and there are 25 Small Training Centers at district level for conduction of one day Safety Seminar for employees and Public for Safety Awareness.

- b) Organization of Joint conferences and seminars, Industrial visits, Expert lectures etc Monitor process of organizing industry based projects and thesis for graduate & postgraduate students.
- c) Practical training of NBN Sinhgad School of Engineering, Sinhgad Institute of Technology, Lonavala college of Students/Staff at M.S.E.D.C.L, Institute of Training & safety
- d) MSEDCL may request to design a Course or Courses to enhance quality and performance of its employees. Such Courses may be run at any mutually convenient premises.
- e) MSEDCL may seek assistance/guidance of NBN Sinhgad School of Engineering, Sinhgad Institute of Technology, Lonavala Faculty member/s introduce/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, etc.
- f) NBN Sinhgad School of Engineering, Sinhgad Institute of Technology, Lonavala & MSEDCL would arrange discussion sessions for the staff and students, which will help NBNSOE, SITL to design its Syllabus, Vision & Mission of the Institute & Departments, Program Objectives, Course Objectives according to the current requirement of the MSEDCL, as well as design various certificates and diploma courses for the requirement of MSEDCL.

This MOU is non-binding in nature and does not create any legal obligations between the Parties, except for the Intellectual property provisions in Section 5, confidentiality provisions in Section 7 and dispute resolution provisions in Section 10. The Partner Institute and WOF agree to work together to systematically develop the entrepreneurship programs described below.

Partner Institute and WOF are hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties" as the context may require.

Terms of the Entrepreneurship Development - Institutional Association MOU:

1. Objectives:

- Structure, content and methodology for Student E Leader training **(for E Cells).**
- Access to Entrepreneur engagement platform **E Week.**
- Program Advisory service to the entrepreneurship faculty **and E Cell leaders.**
- Framework for entrepreneurship outcomes and **impact assessment measurement.**

Partner Institute shall provide the following:

- Develop/strengthen the institutional mandate for entrepreneurship education and development.
- Mainstream (as required or elective courses) entrepreneurship curricula within the Partner Institute for holistic development of students' knowledge, skills and experiences and implemented the courses and practicum as prescribed by WOF-NEN.
- IT infrastructure (sufficient bandwidth to provide live and uninterrupted student-device level access in classroom of WOF content) to enable students to learn using modern blended learning methodologies.
- Designate and support required numbers of motivated faculty towards entrepreneurship and provide for their training. Training will be provided by WOF designated Master Trainers. Institutes will have to bear expenses towards attending such training programs, including their proportion of Master trainer expenses.
- Support practicum programs on campus with required faculty supervision including engagement with entrepreneurs and professionals knowledgeable about venture creation.

Such communication will be sent via email to the registered email address which will be provided at the time of the registration on the Online Learning Platform.

3. Financial Terms: Each Party will bear the costs of meeting its responsibilities described in Section 2 above and will not owe the other Party any amounts pursuant to this MOU.

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4. Review Process: Both Parties will review progress of the programs conducted pursuant to the MOU on at least a half-yearly basis. The Head of the Partner institute will participate in the final review for each year to ensure that the management is fully apprised of the development of the programs. The Partner Institute is expected to track progress and data of students, student entrepreneurs, and entrepreneurs that it works with during the course of this association.

5. Intellectual Property Rights

- "Intellectual Property" includes creations, domain names, inventions, know-how, trade or business secrets, patents, copyrights, trademarks, logos, designs, works of authorship, software programmes, papers, models, teaching techniques, research projects, databases and instruction manuals.
- Each Party shall retain all rights to its IP and nothing contained in this MOU, nor the use of the IP in the publicity, advertising, or promotional or other material relating to the fulfillment of the obligations of the Parties contained herein shall be construed as giving to any Party any right, title or interest of any nature whatsoever to any of the other Party's IP.
- Partner Institute will not copy or reproduce in any form, WOF's IP.

6. Representations and Warranties:

- Each Party hereby represents and warrants that the use of IP made available or contributed by it does not violate the IP rights of any third party.
- Each Party has all requisite power and authority to enter into this MOU and the execution, delivery and performance by such Party of this MOU has been authorised by all necessary and appropriate corporate or governmental action and will not, to the best of its knowledge, violate any applicable law or approval presently in effect and applicable to it.

7. Confidentiality:

- The Parties acknowledge that during the term of this MOU each Party may obtain confidential and/or proprietary information of the other Party including, but not limited to, financial or business information, contracts and employee details (collectively, "Proprietary Information"). Such Proprietary Information shall belong solely to the disclosing Party. Proprietary Information shall not include information that is or becomes publicly known through no wrongful act of the receiving Party.
- The receiving Party shall not disclose Proprietary Information to third parties without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party and agrees to undertake reasonable measures to ensure that such is kept confidential and to disclose to its employees, officers, directors or representatives on a need to know basis only.
- The receiving Party also agrees to report immediately to the disclosing Party any unauthorized disclosure of Proprietary Information of which it has knowledge.

8. Third Party:

- Nothing in this MOU shall mean or shall be construed to mean that either Party is at any time precluded from having similar arrangements with any other person or third party.
- The Parties shall wherever necessary enter into definite written agreements with/without third parties to facilitate the implementation of specific initiatives with the prior written consent of the other Party. Such agreements will be independent and exclusive of this MOU.
- Each Party will promptly notify the other Party of any potential conflict of interest arising from the conduct of activity pursuant to this MOU as soon as it is known by the

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Party that becomes aware of the potential conflict.

9. Termination:

- a) This MOU is for the duration of three (3) years from the date of this MOU. However, either Party may terminate or extend this MOU by providing 60 days' notice in writing to the other Party. In the event that the Partner Institute would like to continue operating under the terms of the MOU because of student enrollment in courses conducted pursuant to this MOU, despite having received notice of termination from WOF, WOF will support the students until the end of the course, on submission of proof that the enrollments took place before the date of the termination notice.
- b) If the Partner Institute does not fulfil its responsibilities, WOF will discontinue the program and the Partner Institute shall cease to be a member.

- b) **Amendment:** This MOU shall not be amended, changed, modified in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing signed by both the Parties hereto.
- c) **Relationship of Parties:** Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating a relationship of partnership, joint venture, agency or employment between the Parties. Neither Party shall be responsible for the acts or omissions of the other Party, nor shall either Party have the power or authority to speak for or assume any obligation on behalf of the other Party.
- d) **Assignment:** Each Party may assign its rights and obligations under this MOU with the prior written consent of the other Party. Notwithstanding the foregoing, WOF shall be entitled to assign any of its rights and obligations to any of its affiliates without the prior written consent of the Partner Institute. It is clarified that:
 - i. The assignment or alienation of any part or whole of the Partner Institute IP or WOF IP shall not be construed to be an assignment of rights or obligations under this MOU; and

VAP on Programming with C, C++, Core Java

The following Terms of Service (the "Agreement") is effective 1st August 2016 to 1st August 2022.

BETWEEN: Global Infotech (the "Service Provider"), a private firm and, with its head office located at;

AND: Sinhgad Institute of Technology,
Department of Computer Engg.

Gat No 309/310, Off Pune-Mumbai Express Highway, Kusgaon (Bk), Lonavala 410401 hereby referred to as SIT Lonavala (the "Client") being party of the other part.

WHEREAS, the Service Provider is in the business of development, supply and operation of products and services related to technical education and training in the field of programming and software development; and

WHEREAS, the Service Provider is setting up Value addition Program in which it has approached the Client to participate on a mutually beneficial basis; and

WHEREAS, the Client has expressed its interest in running the Value addition Program at its premises and is committed to working towards making it a success; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement contains the Service Provider's terms of engagement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto, intending, to be legally bound, agree as follows:

1. SERVICES PROVIDED

In order to meeting the increasing demand of technical students and engineering educational institutes about providing quality technical education the Service Provider has come out with a proactive program to share its knowledge with the students at the

Client's location. The Service Provider has agreed to manage and run the Value addition Program at the Client's premises for a period of 40 hours.

2. GENERAL TERMS OF SERVICE

- a. The Service Provider will manage and run courses on "C programming, C++ and Core Java" at the Client's premises for a period of 40 hours each. These courses will be certified by Service provider and SIT, Lonavala.
- b. All correspondence between the Service Provider and the Client will be done in writing. The Client will nominate an authorized person who will be the figurehead for all future correspondence.
- c. A program schedule will be provided by the Service Provider to the Client within 7 days of signing of this agreement. This schedule will be designed in close coordination with the Client's authorized person.
- d. Detailed Schedule and contents for each module will be provided to participating students in advance. The timetable of the course will be displayed well in advance and will be strictly followed. In case the schedule conflicts with any internal exam / test, the matter is to be resolved with mutual understanding. At the end of module, examination to evaluate performance of student will be conducted. The results are to be displayed.
- e. At the end of module, Service Provider is supposed to get done the small project from every student on the basis the entire course content.
- f. All items related to course schedule, fee and payment schedule are present in Annexure A of this document.
- g. When there is need to take the students for any industrial visit, the travel costs shall be borne by Global Infotech along with its industry partner.

3. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SERVICE PROVIDER

- a. The Service Provider will run courses on "C programming, C++ and Core Java" at the Client's premises. These courses will run for 40 hour for 2nd year/3rd year students. All resources required in terms of course delivery, trainers, content required, hands-on training kits and courseware will be brought in by the Service Provider.
- b. The Service Provider will give Intern training at their Head office to the best performing students. The decision will be taken by mutual understanding at both end.
- c. At the end of module, Service Provider is supposed to get done the small project from every student on the basis the entire course content.

4. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CLIENT

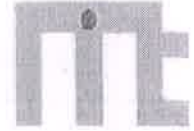

- a. The Client will take proactive steps towards promotion of the Value Addition Program. In this regards the Client will nominate one authorized person who will be the direct communication link between the Service Provider and the Client.
- b. In order to make the Value Addition Program a success a minimum of 30 students are required to be enrolled for a period of 40 hours. After the module MOD1.1 the enrollment for next module is the responsibility of both client and service provider and is based on feedback received from enrolled students during module MOD1.1. The Client will provide at no cost to the Service Provider relevant publicity measures in order to meet the minimum requirement of 50 students for the program.
- c. The Client shall also provide the necessary infrastructure required for the program. These include necessary classrooms, computer labs, projectors and other reasonable infrastructure required for the commencement of the course itself. Lodging & boarding costs shall be borne by Sukrut faculties for the duration of training program (4 faculty members), Nominal cost will be offered by STES.
- d. Detailed Schedule and contents for each module will be provided to participating students in advance. The timetable of the course will be displayed well in advance and will be strictly followed. In case the schedule conflicts with any internal exam / test, the matter is to be resolved with mutual understanding. At the end of each module, examination to evaluate performance of student will be conducted. The results are to be displayed.
- e. When there is need to take the students for any industrial visit, the travel costs shall be borne by Global infotech long with its industry partner.
- f. The Client will undertake all measures toward effective collection of fees for the program conducted by the Service Provider, details of fee structure are documented in Annexure A.

5. TERM OF THE CONTRACT

The Service Agreement will be valid for a term of two years from the date of signing of this agreement and can be extended on mutual consent.

6. TERMINATION BY THE CLIENT

Client may terminate this agreement by giving the Service Provider a one month written notice. However the Client will consider the recommended students till the date of termination of the contract and will be liable to the above obligations for the recommended set of students.

7. TERMINATION BY THE SERVICE PROVIDER

Service Provider may terminate this agreement and stop acting for the Client if;

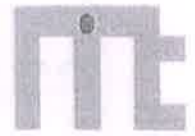
- a. The Client doesn't comply with the agreement; or




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- b. Service Provider forms the opinion, on reasonable grounds, that mutual confidence and trust do not exist between both parties; or
- c. Service Provider believes on reasonable grounds that, by continuing to act for the Client, it may breach the professional conduct rules which are binding upon professionals in the education industry.

8. MUTUAL SUPPORT AND COOPERATION

Each of the Service Provider and the Client agrees that it will take all steps reasonably necessary, at its own expense, to;

- a. To designate key individuals to perform its obligations here under.
- b. The conduct periodic meetings of all such key individuals and others as necessary.
- c. To fully cooperate with all reasonable requests for assistance.

The parties will make diligent efforts through their respective key individuals to identify the causes of any problems in the services and to make adjustments, in an equitable fashion, in order to address and resolve such problems.

9. NON EXCLUSIVE NATURE

Both parties agree that this agreement represents a non-exclusive relationship between the parties and nothing contained herein shall preclude either party from participating/initiating similar relationships with third party. However the Client shall not engage another Service Provider in similar domain conducting similar activities for the period of association, provided service provider satisfies interest of client and students.

10. NON DISCLOSURE

- a. The Client undertakes not to disclose or allow to be disclosed or copy or allow to be copied any material, collateral, training guides, books or manuals, strategies etc provided by the Service Provider to any other third party or institutions.
- b. Neither party shall issue any press release, public announcement or other such disclosure concerning this Agreement without the other party's prior consent as to such release or announcement.

11. NON SOLICITATION

The Service Provider and the Client recognize that their individual employees, consultants and other resource personnel are invaluable assets for the respective organizations and undertake that they will not recruit, attempt to recruit, employ or offer any work or consulting to any employee, consultant or resource person from each other's organizations either directly or indirectly for a period of a year after the termination of the contract.

PRINCIPAL

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12. ARBITRATION

Differences of opinions, if any arising during the period of the agreement, will be settled on the basis of mutual consultation by the signatories or their designated nominees. In the event of any question, dispute or differences arising under these conditions with this agreement, except as to any matters the decision of which is specially provided for by these or the special conditions, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of two signatories of this agreement. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to this contract.

The venue of the Arbitration will be finalized later on in such case.

13. FORCE MAJEURE

Any failure or delay in the performance of the Service Provider of its obligations hereunder shall not be a breach of this Agreement if such failures or delay arises out of or results primarily from fire, storm, flood, or other acts of God, explosions, wars, insurrections, strikes, work stoppages or slowdowns, epidemics or quarantine restrictions, unforeseen equipment failure or inability to access essential raw materials despite commercially reasonable best efforts to do so.

14. INDEMNITY CLAUSE

Each of the parties shall defend, indemnify and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, liability, loss, costs or expenses (including reasonable Attorney's fees) arising out of or resulting from the breach of the provisions herein.

15. NOTICES

All notices, requests, demands and other communications under this agreement or in connection herewith shall be given to or made upon the respective parties as follows:

Schedule

Course Fees

- Global Infotech and SIT will charge a course fee of INR 1800 for C programming and C++, INR 2200 for Core Java per student for the value Addition Program. Payment Schedules

- 50% of the Course Fee to be collected by the Client and paid to the Service provider after completion of 20 hrs module and remaining 50% prior to the commencement of the program.
- The payment will be made in Favor of "Global Infotech" by either/cheque/ DD or RTGS.
- For any conflicts or misunderstanding or discrepancies the issues will be sorted out with mutual understandings.
